

## What you need:

### SCOTCH PAPER - SCISSORS - SPATULA\*.

\*If you did not buy a spatula, you can use an object with a flat but **not sharp** surface. We recommend a kitchen spatula or a flat object covered with a cotton cloth. If you only use your hands to adhere the adhesive, we recommend using a cotton glove or cloth.

## Assembly:

1. Separate each sticker by cutting it out externally. Be careful not to cut the subjects.
2. Decide how to place the stickers on the wall by temporarily fixing them with paper tape. Remember that once the sticker is attached, it cannot be repositioned.
3. Proceed by attaching each sticker in this way:

#### SMALL STICKERS:

Remove the base film and adhere the adhesive to the wall with the help of the spatula, trying not to create creases and air bubbles.

#### LARGE STICKERS:

Place the sticker by fixing it in the centre with paper tape:

Starting from one side, separate part of the base foil and remove it by cutting it off with scissors:



Adhere the adhesive to the wall from the centre outwards with the help of the squeegee:

Remove the tape paper and remove the remaining base film while holding the adhesive taut:



With the spatula, continue to adhere the adhesive to the wall from the centre outwards, avoiding the creation of bubbles and creases:



### ATTENTION

If **air bubbles** form, try moving them out of the nearest edge with the spatula. Or you can make a small hole with a sewing needle to let the air escape.

 **Do not rub the adhesive with abrasive materials.**

 **Do not use alcohol-based cleaning products.**
